The Timeline

December 2018 - A previous tax to upgrade Manitou Avenue sunsets.

January 2019 - Michelle Anthony and Natalie Johnson, while discussing how sad it was that the tax ended with no new initiatives, have a brilliant idea.

March 2019 - The campaign begins.

July 2019 - The group starts collecting signatures.

November 2019 - The initiative is on the ballot, albeit a bit changed - and it passes.....by a mere 6 votes.

November 2019 - * CELEBRATION!!! *

December 2019 - City Council declines to formally ratify the measure - and causes an uproar. Democracy feels dead.

January 2020 - A new City Council is sworn in. They immediately institute the tax.

July 2020 - The tax collecting begins.

The Tax Structure



Approximately \$2.1 million has been allocated as of 2024 - about \$95 per Manitou resident, per year



66% paid to Tier One brick-and-mortar organizations - the Manitou Art Center, the Manitou Heritage Center, Miramont Castle, the Carnegie Library, and Hiawatha Gardens - \$337,402 in 2024



34% distributed through grants, funding nonprofit groups, fiscally sponsored groups, and individual creatives - \$167,000 awarded to 47 separate projects, ranging from \$400 to \$14,400 in 2024
